INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

Bids will be received at the Lassen Transit Service Agency, Lassen County, 707 Nevada Street, Ste. 4, Susanville, California 96130, until **4:00 pm on August 14, 2020**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the conference room at the above address.

Each Bid must be submitted to the Agency in a sealed envelope, addressed to Lassen Transit Service Agency at 707 Nevada Street, Ste. 4, Susanville, California 96130. The Bid must be submitted on the P-2 Bid Form. Failure to do so may exclude bid from consideration as non-responsive. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be clearly marked on the outside as **Bid for Surplus Property for Scrap – Bus 17**. The envelope should bear on the outside the name of the Bidder, the Bidder's address, and the Bidder's license number if applicable. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to Lassen Transit Service Agency at 707 Nevada Street, Ste. 4, Susanville, California 96130. Successful bidder will be responsible for removal/hauling of vehicle within 15 calendar days from bid award. Failure to remove vehicle within 15 days may void bid award.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting

There will not be a mandatory pre-bid meeting. However, proposed bidders can view the surplus property at the Lassen Rural Bus facility located at 701-980 Johnstonville Road in Susanville, CA 96130 on Wednesday August 5, 2020 and Wednesday August 12, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Individual bidders shall sign the Bid with their full name and address. A partner or a Partnership submitting a Bid shall sign the Bid with his or her full name and the name and address of every member of the Partnership shall be given. A duly authorized officer(s) of a corporation submitting a Bid shall sign the Bid with his/her/their full name(s) attested by the corporate seal, and the names and titles of all officers(s) of the corporation shall be given on the Bid.

The Agency will not consider for award more than one Bid from an individual, firm, partnership, corporation, or association under the same or different names. A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted.

The Agency may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all bids. Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of Bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any Bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No Bidder may withdraw a Bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the Project shall apply to the Contract throughout.

The Agency may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the work, and the Bidder shall furnish to the Agency all such information and data for this purpose as the Agency may request. The Agency reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the Agency that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the Work contemplated therein. The Agency reserves the right to reject any or all bids at its sole discretion.

Each Bidder and Contractor shall be licensed in accordance with the laws of the State of California including but not limited to Chapter 9, Division III of the Business and Professions Code, Section 7000 et seq. Any Bidder or Contractor not so licensed is subject to the penalties imposed by law.

The successful contractor will be required to enter into a Bill of Sale with the Agency.

The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to his Bid.
