

## BUS REGULATIONS

- ❖ Avoid unnecessary conversation with the driver while the bus is in motion.
- ❖ Carriages and strollers must be folded and out of the aisle.
- ❖ Eating or drinking open containers is not allowed on the buses.
- ❖ **NO SMOKING** in or around buses, bus stops and bus shelters. *This includes e-cigarettes.*
- ❖ Pets, other than service animals, must be kept in pet carriers.
- ❖ Shirts and shoes must be worn while on the bus.
- ❖ Defacing LRB property in any way will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Music/video devices are allowed only when headphones are used.
- ❖ Weapons of any kind will not be tolerated in or around LRB facilities or vehicles.
- ❖ Profanity (*swearing or cursing*) is not allowed.
- ❖ **NO LITTERING** on buses, bus stops or bus shelters.
- ❖ Unruly or bothersome behavior is not allowed.
- ❖ Children 10 years of age or under must be accompanied by an adult.
- ❖ Up to 3 children under age 6 ride for free; after that the reduced fare applies
- ❖ Do not block the exit. Please leave the front seats vacant for persons who are elderly or have a disability.
- ❖ No spitting. Sec 640a (5)
- ❖ Fighting or fighting words are not permitted. Sec 640a(6)
- ❖ Vandalism is a crime. Violators will be prosecuted. Sec 640 a (5)
- ❖ Verbal abuse, use of profane language while communicating with transit staff will not be tolerated. Sec 640a(6)
- ❖ Evasion of payment of fare or misuse of any fare instruments to avoid payment of fare to the system. Sec 640 a(2)
- ❖ Willfully blocking the free movement of any person or the Vehicle in the system. Sec 640a (9a)
- ❖ Posting, distributing or displaying any sign, advertisement, circular, handbill, or other written material without prior approval. Sec 640.5a (1)
- ❖ No skateboarding, rollerblading or skating at any transit facility. Sec 640.5a (10)
- ❖ A person may not be in a LRB facility or vehicle with an unavoidable grossly repulsive odor so extreme it causes a nuisance, unreasonably interferes with the use, operation, or enjoyment of the LRB facilities or vehicles for LRB representatives or patrons, or creates an unsafe condition. Extreme odors may arise from a variety of sources, including one's body, possessions, clothing, food, chemicals, or accompanying animals. CIVIL CODE SECTION 3479-3486.5
